1.0 GENERAL TERMS

2.0 PROMOTER'S DETAILS

4.2 The competition opens at **9:00am AEST on Wednesday, 10 September 2025** and closes at **11:59pm AEST on Wednesday, 17 September 2025**.

5.0 HOW TO WIN

5.1 This is a **game of skill**. Chance plays no part in determining the winners.

5.2 All valid entries will be judged by a panel appointed by the Canterbury-Bankstown Bulldogs. Judging criteria include:

- Creativity;
 - Expression of Bulldogs pride;
 - Relevance to the blue and white theme;
 - Community impact.
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6.0 WINNER REQUIREMENTS

6.1 Winners must:

- Be available to accept their prize at a Bulldogs-organised event or via collection/delivery as arranged by the Promoter.
